

**TRAFFIC ORDINANCE FOR STATE HIGHWAYS**  
**Town of Groton, Vermont**

**ARTICLE 1. AUTHORITY.** This ordinance is adopted by the Town of Groton under authority granted by 24 V.S.A. Chapter 59, 23 V.S.A. § 1007 and 13 V.S.A. § 7251.

**ARTICLE 2. PURPOSE.** The purpose of this ordinance is to promote public safety.

**ARTICLE 3. SEVERABILITY.** If any portion of this ordinance is held unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected.

**ARTICLE 4.** The maximum speed limit permitted for any vehicular traffic on Vermont State Highways within the Town of Groton shall be the same as those limits established and posted by the State of Vermont, to wit:

On Scott Highway US Route 302 a maximum of 50-mph with the exceptions: a maximum speed limit of 40-mph beginning 0.15 +/- miles east of TH-48, Welton Rd (mp 6.00+/-), extending easterly to 0.03 +/- miles west of TH-49, Mill St. (mp 6.40 +/-), and then from this point, 30-mph to 0.08 +/- miles east of TH-32, Tannery Brook Rd (mp 6.85 +/-), and then from this point, 35-mph to 0.14 +/- miles West of TH-61, New Cemetery Rd (mp 7.15 +/-).

On State Forest road VT Route 232 a maximum of 50-mph with the exception: a maximum speed limit of 40-mph beginning 0.56 +/- miles south of TH-65, Ricker Mill Rd (mp 1.50 +/-), extending northerly to the Peacham Town line (mp 7.18 +/-).

**ARTICLE 5. STOP INTERSECTIONS**

The following intersections are designated as stop intersections and are so signed:

Daniels road T.H.#34 entering Scott Highway US Route 302  
    at both ends of Daniels road


### ARTICLE 6. PENALTIES.

- a. This is a civil ordinance which shall be enforced in accordance with the provisions in 24 V.S.A. §§ 1974a and 1977 et seq.
- b. The penalty for violation of any of the above speed limits and stop intersections shall be that set by the Schedule of Fines established by the State of Vermont.

**ARTICLE 6. ENFORCEMENT OFFICIALS.** Issuing officials shall include any officer from the Caledonia County Sheriff's Department, any certified constable of the Town of Groton, and any Vermont State Police officer.

**ARTICLE 7. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall become effective 60 days after its adoption by the Groton Selectboard. If a petition is filed under 24 V.S.A. § 1973, the taking effect of this ordinance shall be governed by that statute.
