ALL CONTAINERS NEED TO BE WASHED/RINSED OUT!

NEWSPAPERS, MAGAZINES & OFFICE PAPER (JUNK MAIL): Can be mixed together - Includes catalogs, telephone books, egg cartons, glossy inserts and paperback books as well as colored paper, white paper, wrapping paper and junk mail. Any color or type of paper can be in this category. **Except, NO** brown Kraft (grocery) bags or boxboard, **NO** food soiled paper plates and trash. Remove metal/plastic spiral binders.

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD: **NO** wax-coated cardboard, cardboard soiled with food waste or Styrofoam. Remove excess tape. Staples are OK. REMOVE ALL CONTENTS, INNER WRAPPINGS, plastic or styrofoam.
BREAK DOWN AND FLATTEN!

BROWN KRAFT BAGS & BOXBOARD: **NO** wax-coated boxboard, gable-top containers like milk and juice, **NO** strings, handles or bags with plastic layers.

TIN CANS: Labels are OK. Rinse clean. Flattening not required but encouraged. Separate from aluminum cans (A magnet will stick to tin but not to aluminum). **NO** aerosol cans, paint cans, etc., those are for the scrap metal pile.

ALUMINUM CANS, FOIL AND FOOD TRAYS: Labels OK. Flattening not required, keep clean. Snack bags and candy wrappers are **not** aluminum foil! **NO** construction debris, that is for the metal scrap pile.

GLASS (ALL COLORS): Clear, green, blue, and amber bottles and jars. Dishes, window, mirror, crystal, ceramic, Pyrex and drinking glasses are acceptable. Rinse clean. **NO** lids or caps, metal or wood. **NO** light bulbs.

#1 through #7 PLASTICS: Look for the recycling number stamped on the bottom of the container. Includes all **labeled** rigid plastic containers and lids. Labels are **OK**, *please crush larger containers.* Tubs and automotive product containers are acceptable as long as they are completely drained of fluid. Rinse all containers please! **NO** vinyl siding, **NO Styrofoam** (styrofoam will have air cells and could have a recycling number, *still not accepted*), **NO** syringes or medical devices please – call NEKWMD for proper disposal options.

PLASTIC BAGS: Any plastic bag that is **labeled #2 or #4**, or has been identified as such. Agricultural wrap is **OK**, *if it is all white.* Call for the current list of acceptable bags. White Market okay.

SPECIAL WASTES: Oil, Oil Filters, Automotive Batteries, Rechargeable Batteries, Agricultural Bale Wrap, Hard and Soft covered Books, Printer Cartridges, Lead fishing sinkers, Propane tanks, Cellular Phones, Electronics (TV's & Computers), Tires and Fluorescent Bulbs are all collected year round. **FEES apply for electronics and tires only.**

SCRAP METAL: Bulk scrap metal is taken each week also. **WHITE** Goods-stoves, dryers, freezers, and refrigerators are accepted-**KEEP FREEZERS and REFRIGERATORS UPRIGHT, and disable or detach the doors! THANKS**

PLANETAID: We now also accept **clothing!** *It needs to be bagged and bundled neatly* to fit in the receptacle provided by the Planet Aid Organization. You can check them out at www.planetaid.org.

IN LYNDONVILLE

Clothing and Textiles – Drop and Swaps are held in the spring and fall in Derby and Lyndonville.

Scrap Metal, White Goods, and Tires – Snow-free months, Mon-Fri 8:00AM – 4:00PM and Saturday 8:00AM to 3:00PM. Fees apply for tires.

Household Hazardous Waste – **BY APPOINTMENT ONLY**, Monday – Friday, June through the end of September in Lyndonville, and special events throughout the District June – September. Call for details.

SWAP SHOP: In Lyndonville - Pick-up or drop-off any small, clean household item in good working condition.
