

2020 GENERAL ELECTION INFORMATION

The State of Vermont will be sending the General Election ballot to all registered Active voters by the end of September. The ballot will also include the Justice of the Peace candidates on the back of the ballot.

If you haven't received your ballot by early October, check in with the Town Clerk's office. These ballots can be mailed back in the postage paid envelope included with the ballot; it's recommended you allow a week for delivery, or you can return it in person to the Town Clerk or it can be put into the Drop Box in the entryway of the Town Clerk's office. All ballots must be returned to Town Clerk by 7p.m. of Election Day, November 3rd. Any ballots received after will not be counted.

We will still have in person voting on November 3rd. from 10a.m to 7p.m. in the Groton Community Building.
