

NOTICE TO VOTERS

BEFORE ELECTION DAY:

CHECKLIST POSTED at Clerks Office by January 31, 2021. If your name is not on the checklist, then you must register to vote.

HOW TO REGISTER TO VOTE: There is no deadline to register to vote. You will be able to register to vote on the day of the election.** You can register prior by visiting the Town Clerk's office or going online to <https://olvr.vermont.gov/>

REQUEST EARLY or ABSENTEE BALLOTS: You can request early or absentee ballots at any time during the year of the election in person, in writing, by telephone, email or online at <https://mvp.vermont.gov/>.

WAYS TO VOTE YOUR EARLY BALLOT:

- You may vote in the Town Clerk's office before noon on March 1, 2021
- Voter may take his or her ballot out of the Clerk's office and return in the same manner as if the ballots were received by mail.
- Have ballot mailed to you, and mail or deliver it back to the Clerk's office before Election Day or to the polling place before 7:00pm on Election Day.
- If you are sick or disabled, before Election Day ask the Town Clerk to have two Justices of the Peace bring a ballot to you at your home. (Ballots can be delivered on any of the eight days preceding the day of the election or on the day of election.)

**Election officials are active participants in the Town Meeting/Election, so registering at the polls may require you to wait until there is a break in the meeting/Election duties. You are strongly encouraged to register before Election Day, either online or at the town office.
